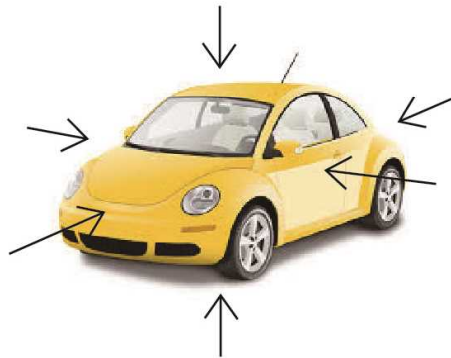

(1) 3-dimensional article (ex. automobile, shoe . . .)



<needed>

6 views (front, rear, top, bottom, left-side, right-side)

※ Mirror images can be omitted.

<preferable, but sometimes needed>
perspective views

※ Sometimes needed, when the configuration cannot be understood without it.

<option>

※ CROSS-SECTIONAL VIEW

Sometimes, some cross-sectional views are needed, for example when it cannot be understood how a wall surface curves or rolls without it (not intended for showing inside).

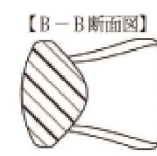
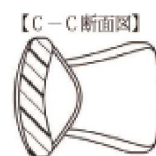
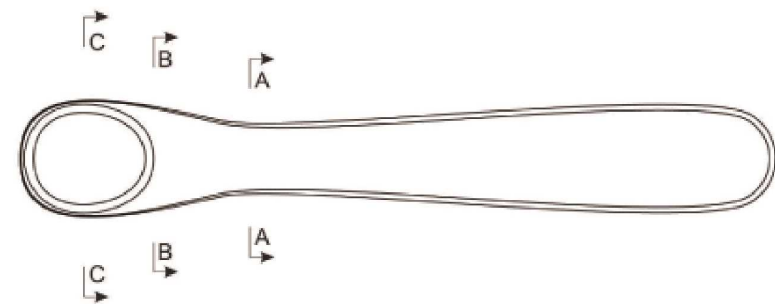
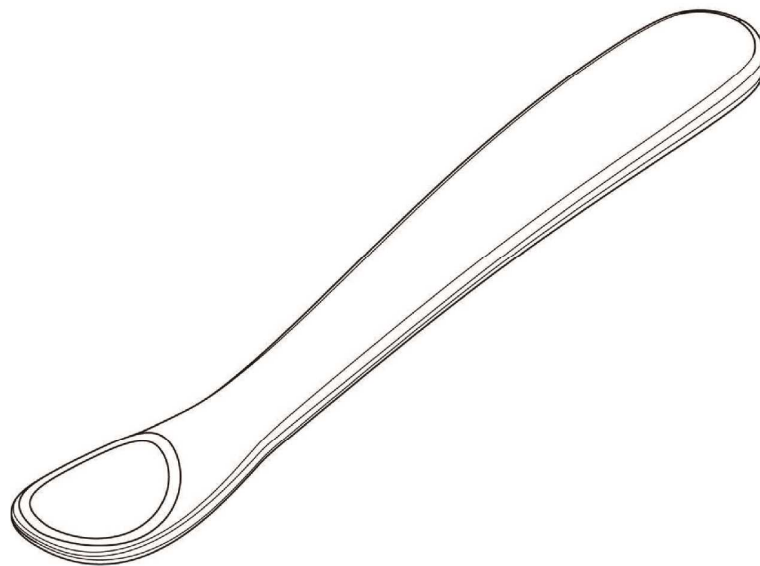
※ OPENED view, CLOSED view

For some kinds of package, OPENED view and CLOSED view are needed.

For example, for a bottle or so, “cap-closed condition” and “cap-removed condition” .

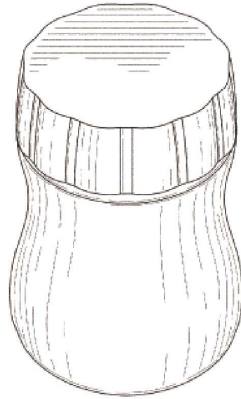

(2) 2-dimensional article (ex. fabric, ornamental leather sheet, • •)



<needed>

2 views (front, rear)

※ If the rear surface of the article is plain and has no decoration, the rear view can be omitted, but the description to say so should be made in the application document.

※ Dimension of the article is often requested to be described.

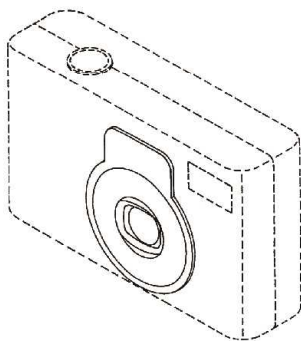
DESCRIPTION

- The surrounding red frame is a background.
- 175mm height (for example).

(3) Part-design



The portion drawn by the solid line is requested to be registered as a part-design.



The portion other than painted in pink is requested to be registered as a part-design.

In the DESCRIPTION, there should be described how the “claim-part” and the “disclaim-part” are distinguished with each other, in the views.
