

Sometimes needed, when the configuration cannot be understood without it.




### **\*\***CROSS-SECTIONAL VIEW

※ OPENED view, CLOSED view For some kinds of package, OPENED view and CLOSED view are needed. For example, for a bottle or so, "cap-closed condition" and "cap-removed condition".
